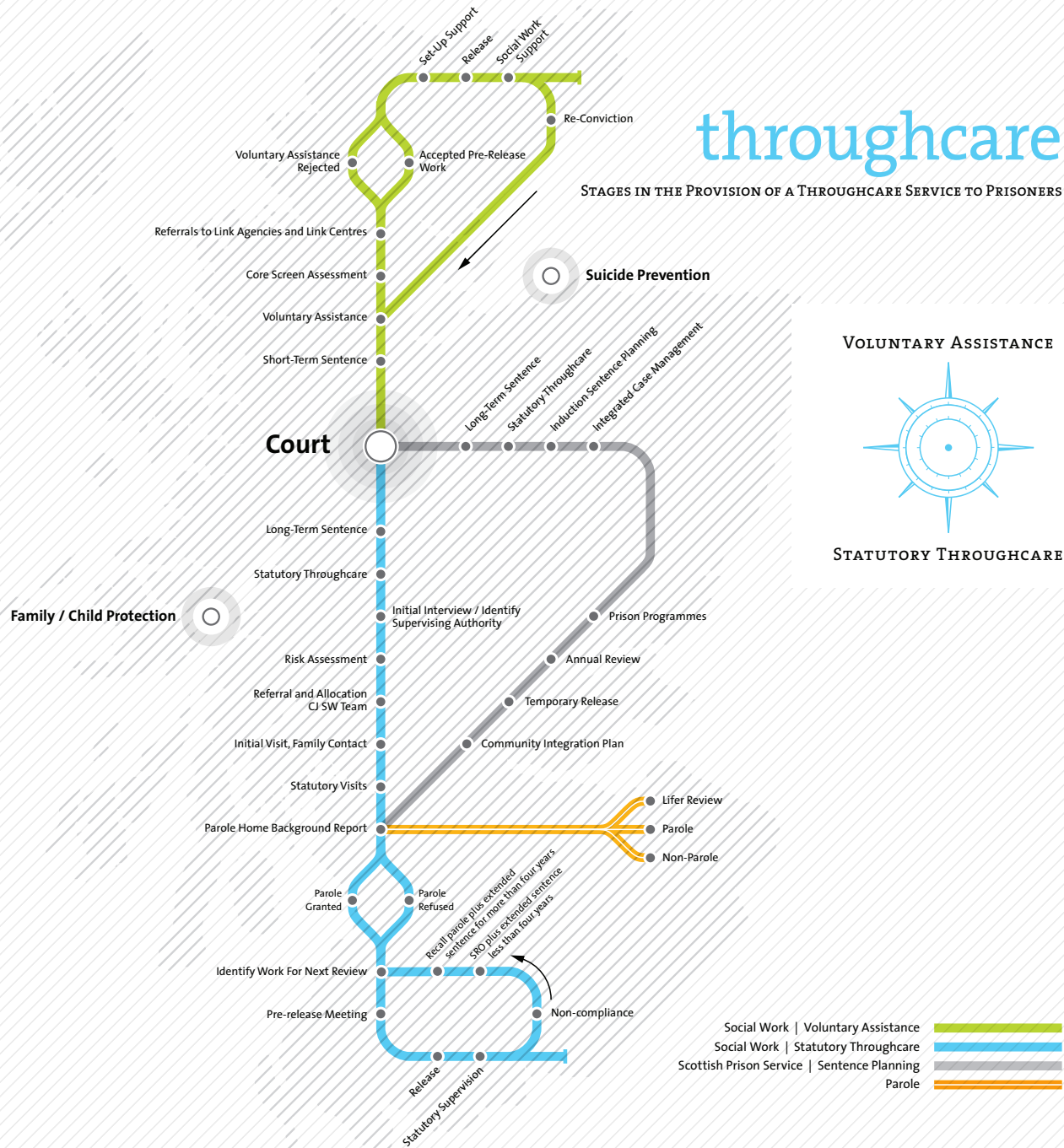

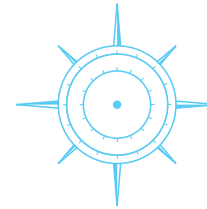
## STAGES IN THE PROVISION OF A THROUGH-CARE SERVICE TO PRISONERS



The Throughcare website is intended to guide users through the various stages involved in the provision of a throughcare service to prisoners, from the point of sentence through to release and supervision within the community. Our hope is that this resource will be of interest to a variety of professionals involved in the throughcare process (including social workers, Scottish Prison Service staff, the voluntary sector etc.), but it should also be of use to those with an interest in criminal justice matters in general.

The large button at the centre of the diagram represents the Court and is the starting point of the Throughcare Map. The coloured lines provide information about Voluntary Assistance, Statutory Throughcare and the joint Scottish Prison Service/Criminal Justice Social Work Sentence Planning process. Flanking the Court button are others representing Suicide Prevention and Family/Child Protection, which apply to all aspects of the throughcare process.
