## 2.5 Role of the Supervising Officer

- 2.5.1 Given the unique nature of the Extended Sentence provision, there are several distinctive features to the role of the Supervising Officer. These include:
  - regular visits to the prisoner on a 6 or 12 monthly basis, according to sentence length
  - $\langle \,$  any Home Background Report for parole purposes to be informed by such an assessment visit
  - 〈 increased contact where appropriate with the offender's family
  - A particularly in cases involving long periods of supervision, an increased emphasis
     on the role of co-ordination and case management, especially those involving
     specialist input to personal change programmes.
